1. 授業のねらい・概要

Many linguists claim that learning vocabulary is the greatest single challenge for students of English as a foreign language. However, the typical ESL course focuses on the mastery of sentence patterns, grammar, and communication. As a result, the systematic study of vocabulary items is generally underemphasized. Mastery of vocabulary associated with our daily activities and the global business environment is necessary to achieve meaningful communication, and the primary objective of this course is to familiarize students with such commonly-used vocabulary.

Aims :

- (1) To introduce students to 4,000 words presented in a meaningful context. These words cover key topics such as everyday language, people, family, business, office, home, market, etc.
- (2) To engage students in communication tasks and readings which require them to repeatedly encounter the words and use them in their respective real-world contexts.

2. 授業の進め方

Students will be introduced to the vocabulary of the day, the meaning of each word, and its correct pronunciation. After the introduction, students will complete language tasks, exercises, and readings which use the words. These activities will provide opportunities to encounter the words in their proper contexts.
